

# **AGREEMENT IAID - INTERNATIONAL ACADEMY OF INNOVATIVE DENTISTRY (IAID) and EA4SD - EUROPEAN ASSOCIATION FOR SPORTS DENTISTRY (EA4SD)**

Effective Date: March 2026

## **1. PREAMBLE**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) establishes a framework for collaboration among the International Academy of Innovative Dentistry (IAID) and the European Association for Sports Dentistry (EA4SD) to promote oral health among athletes, advance education, and foster scientific exchange. This alliance is founded on the shared commitment of both organizations to advance the field of dentistry through high-quality education, the promotion of innovative technologies, and the establishment of global standards of excellence.

## **2. MISSION AND OBJECTIVES**

IAID: A global, multidisciplinary academy focused on promoting excellence in dental and medical treatments through innovative, minimally invasive, and evidence-based approaches.

EA4SD: A European association dedicated to promoting oral health and sports dentistry, focusing on prevention, education, and research.

## **3. CORE AREAS OF COLLABORATION**

This agreement will focus on the following principal areas of collaboration:

- Promotion of oral health among athletes
- Execution of oral health screenings and development of preventive protocols
- Organization of joint scientific and educational events (congresses, courses, webinars)
- Exchange of speakers and participants for events
- Reciprocal participation in conferences and meetings
- Development of clinical and instrumental innovative protocols for sports dentistry
- Shared educational programs and speaker platforms
- When established by an informal preliminary agreement, share the events of the 2 Academies on their respective channels, giving mutual prominence to them

## **4. JOINT ACTIVITIES**

The IAID and EA4SD agree to collaborate on the basis of the following, UPON DECISION OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE EA4SD-IAID:

- Joint organization of courses, workshops, and congresses
- Exchange of educational materials and resources
- Collaboration on research projects and publications
- Promotion of each other's events and activities
- Speaker exchange program
- Jointly sponsored courses and events
- Mutual accreditation of educational activities

## **5. DUAL RECOGNITION FRAMEWORK**

The IAID and EA4SD agree to mutually recognize the educational and professional achievements of their respective members. This dual recognition is a testament to the comparable quality and rigor of the training and certification processes of both organizations.

## **6. MUTUAL ACCREDITATION BENEFITS**

This agreement will enable each organization to leverage the accreditation system of the other, enhancing the value and recognition of their respective educational programs. Courses and educational activities that have been accredited by the IAID will be recognized by the EA4SD for continuing education credits for its members, and vice versa.

## **7. JOINT MARKETING AND PROMOTION**

To maximize the global reach and impact of this collaboration, the IAID and EA4SD will engage in joint marketing and promotional activities:


- Website and social media announcements

## **8. GOVERNANCE AND TERM**

A joint committee with representation from both IAID and EA4SD will oversee the implementation of this MOU. THE COMMITTEE WILL DECIDE ON ALL ABOVE-MENTIONED TOPICS AND THE DECISIONS OF THIS COMMITTEE WILL BE SUBMITTED FOR FINAL APPROVAL TO THE EA4SD AND IAID BOARDS RESPECTIVELY, BEFORE FINAL IMPLEMENTATION. This agreement will be in effect for an initial term of two years, with a review six months prior to expiration to assess effectiveness and consider renewal or termination.
